Proclamation of the Date of Easter at Epiphany

Dear brothers and sis-ters, the glory of the Lord has shown up-on us,
and shall ever be manifest a-mong us, until the day of his
re-turn. Through the rhythms of times and sea-sons let us celebrate
the mysteries of sal-va-tion. Let us recall the year's cul-mi-na-tion,
the Easter Triduum of the Lord: his last sup-per, his
cru-ci-fix-ion, his bu-ri-al and his ris-ing celebrated between the
evening of the first of A-pril and the evening of the fourth of
A-pril. Each Eas-ter— as on each Sun-day— the Holy Church

twenty-third of May. Like-wise the pil-grim Church proclaims the passover
of Christ in the feasts of the holy Mother of God, in the feasts
of the a-pos-tles and saints, and in the commemoration of the faithful
de-par-ted. To Jesus Christ, who was, who is, and who is to
come, Lord_ of time_ and his - to - ry, be
end - less praise, for e - ver and e - ver. R̄. A - men.
